

Adjunct Lecturer for Healthcare Law

The College of Business at San Francisco State University is looking for a part-time lecturer to teach a graduate course in Healthcare Law during the Fall 2017 semester. This course is part of our new MBA Emphasis in Healthcare Administration. The course meets one evening a week (Monday-Thursday, 6:30-9:15 PM) for 15 weeks at our downtown campus (835 Market Street Suite 600, San Francisco, CA 94103). The Fall semester begins in the fourth week of August and ends before Christmas.

A JD or Master's degree is the minimum qualification required for this position. Relevant industry experience is required and teaching experience at the graduate level would be a plus. Topics to be covered in the course include the Affordable Care Act, Privacy and Security (HIPAA), Compliance, Risk Assessment, and Ethics among others. Teaching methods could include lecture, discussion, case studies and field projects among others. Evaluating papers and exams and assigning course grades is the lecturer's responsibility.
