Is the MBA program right for me?

San Francisco State University's MBA program prepares you with the advanced knowledge and skills you need to lead and manage a broad range of businesses. Elective courses are offered in the following areas:

- Accounting
- Decision Sciences/ Operations Research
- Economics
- Finance
- Hospitality and Tourism Management
- Information Systems
- International Business
- Management
- Marketing



Students complete 30 to 48 units of coursework depending on whether they have earned a bachelor's degree in business from an AACSB-accredited school or have completed equivalent courses in business.

Location and Class Hours

Most classes are delivered in a hybrid format (a combination of in-person and online), with some courses offered fully in-person or fully online. In-person classes are delivered at the San Francisco State University Downtown Campus, in the heart of San Francisco's business and tech district.

Classes are held Monday through Friday at convenient hours for full-time and part-time students.

Admission Criteria

The admissions committee reviews an applicant's overall qualifications and takes the following requirements into consideration:

- Completion of a degree equivalent to a four-year U.S. bachelor's degree from a recognized university
- 3.0 Grade Point Average or higher
- GMAT exam: verbal, quantitative, integrated reasoning and writing scores. GRE score is also accepted. Either exam must be taken within the last five years. GMAT/GRE exam may be waived.
- TOEFL, IELTS or PTE exam — taken within the past two years — is required of all applicants who earned their undergraduate degree from a country where the official language is not English.
- Statement of purpose
- Two letters of recommendation
- Résumé
